


PACK A SHOEBOX FOR OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD



Thank you for putting your love into action in such a meaningful way. To catch a glimpse of all God has done this semester, we invite you to read the heartfelt speech given below by our own member and Embrace Grace leader, Kelsey Dramberger.

SPEECH BY KELSEY DRAMBERGER

November 16, 2025

My name is Kelsey Dramberger and I've had the absolute privilege of being one of the leaders of our Embrace Grace group this fall and helping kick off this ministry at our church. I also want to recognize Julie Christianson, my amazing co-leader, and Anita McGinnis, our brilliant Women's Minister. Both have worked tirelessly day in and day out to start this program and get us here today. Each of you reflect God in all that you do, and I am incredibly grateful to learn from you on a daily basis. I also want to take a moment to thank all of our other Embrace Grace leaders and volunteers who show up on a weekly basis to help with kids care, Midweek dinner, bringing snacks to class, helping pamper our moms on their "Me Day," and everyone who contributed to our beautiful event. Without you all, none of this would be possible, and your love is such a testament to God's goodness. Thank you, thank you, thank you!

Now, on to the reason we are here today. Our moms! Twelve weeks ago you each made the brave decision to step through the doors of this church and show up for a group that you knew close to nothing about. Each of you drove 30-45 minutes to get here, pregnant and tired, kids in tow, plenty of reasons not to show up - but you did. Each and every week. And boy am I grateful. Because our group would not have been complete without a single one of you.

Together we laughed and cried each week, and no matter what we each carried in with us on a Wednesday night, we left feeling lighter and more hopeful after our time spent together. We've been through job changes, sciatic pain, and severe pregnancy sickness (even during class), and our first birth with healthy baby boy in October. We've had highs and lows and everything else along the way. Through it all, you all showed up for yourselves and for the group. What a beautiful thing it was to witness each week!

We've talked about the gift of salvation, God's unending grace, the importance of forgiveness, finding our identity in Christ, trusting in God's plans, how to actively seek out God and get to know Him better, but what I really want to remind you all about today is my hope that Embrace Grace will serve as just the beginning of your story and your journey with your faith. As the Embrace Grace founder Amy Ford says, "Don't gain all this momentum to focus more on God and just let it fade away because our 12 weeks together is over. Let this be your launching pad to fly! We want to see you soar! The miracles you've seen are just the beginning. The closer you get to Him, the more miracles you will see. This is the kind of life God wants for you. Even though Embrace Grace is coming to an end, let this be the beginning of growing your spiritual roots and deepening your faith."

Eighteen weeks ago, Anita and I met with the hope of finding a way to love and support pregnant women in our community so we could be the hands and feet of Jesus. Your baby was planned by God, planned

with purpose, and you were chosen to be that baby's mama. Out of all the moms in the world, God chose you to have this baby. But that doesn't mean that pregnancy and motherhood is easy, because in fact it's the opposite, and that's why we're here.

I hope that in the past 12 weeks together you have felt loved, heard, seen, supported, wanted, known, because that's all we've hoped for. To make you feel loved like Jesus loves you and to support you in any way we can as you embark on this next chapter of your life.

Don't forget to read your Bible and study God's word. His word is alive and is our one source of truth for everything we need. I know we've also talked about continuing group in January and doing meet-ups, but also I also encourage you to become more involved in our church. God created us to need connection and we were not made to do life alone. Austin Baptist Church has an incredible community filled with resources for families and an amazing children's ministry to plug into. And hey, if you want to give your life to Christ or talk about getting baptized, please come chat any day, any time, with me, Julie, or Anita!

And lastly to wrap this thing up, so we can get to the super fun opening of all the gifts, I just want to a say a personal thank you to each of you. Thank you for allowing me into your lives. Thank you for opening your minds and your hearts each week and for allowing me to be a small part of your story. I can't even begin to say how meaningful these past three months have been with y'all, but I can tell you honestly that my life has been forever changed because of each of you. You have taught me more than you'll ever know about resilience, about faith, about perseverance, about poise. Each of you are wonderfully made by our God, as are your babies, and from the bottom of my heart please know how grateful I am to know you. And also I love you!

Guest Article - November 19, 2025 "Don't Discount God" by Annabelle McGinnis Jenkins

One day, I was excited because I planned to go to Aldi and buy groceries after work. I had gotten all prepared. I had made a list and even got my reusable grocery bags ready the night before. On my way to Aldi though, I noticed a crucial component was missing — a quarter to get a buggy. As I was driving, I prayed to God and told him, "I trust that you will provide a quarter for me in some way since you always take care of me." I heard God say, "Check in your wallet for a quarter." In my haste and anxiousness to get into the store, I checked my wallet quickly but didn't see a quarter. I said to myself, "It's okay, I will just use my reusable grocery bags to get my groceries. I don't need a buggy." At first it was fine just using the bags because they were empty and light. But the further I got into the store and started loading it down with more food, the heavier the bag got. By the end of my trip, I was tired and grouchy. Nevertheless, I was determined to finish what I'd started, so I heaved my groceries onto the conveyor belt to check out. As I reloaded my items into my bag to head out of the store, I hear God once again say, "Check your wallet and this time, take your time." So, I listened and looked again, making sure to take my time. There, hidden in between some cards, was a quarter. How much easier would that quarter have made my whole shopping experience if I had just taken my time to listen and trust in what God had told me.

God was using this Aldi experience to show me that even though I say, "I trust you Lord," my actions don't reflect that. My actions showed that I put more trust in myself and my timing. But putting trust in myself makes my burdens heavier and heavier, much like the grocery bags. God taught me that I need to slow down, refocus on Him, and let Him carry my "bags". What bags are you carrying that you can give to the Lord?

"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." Matthew 11:28-30 (NIV)



Please, Sorry, Thanks: Three Words that Change Everything by Mark Batterson

Mark Batterson has a Doctor of Ministry from Regent University and is the author of 25 books, including one children's book which he wrote for his daughter. Batterson serves at the National Community Church in Washington D.C. as the "Lead Visionary." The National Community Church owns and operates several organizations that are gathering places for community. These include: Ebenezers Coffee, Miracle Theatre, the DC Dream Center, the Capital Turnaround, and Culture House. Batterson's website says he, "...also serves as the Lead Visionary for The Dream Collective, which equips and supports dreamers who long for revival in the church, reformation in the kingdom, and renaissance in culture."

In the book *Please*, *Sorry*, *Thanks*, Batterson points to how your words can determine your destiny in life. He says that our words can be self-fulfilling prophecies. Studies show that speaking negative words to plants can cause them to grow weak but that speaking positive words can help them flourish. The same is true for people. Our words reveal the condition of our heart. If you want to change your life, your relationships, and your attitude, you must change your words. This book is divided into three parts. Each part has five chapters. Part one of the book discusses The Psychology Of Please. The word "please" can open hearts, minds, and doors. Part two presents The Science Of Sorry. The word "sorry" can mend broken relationships. Part three discusses The Theology Of Thanks. The word "thanks" when used sincerely can build bridges and be, "the flywheel of gratitude." These three little words hold the secret to success in life, love, and leadership. Batterson says that these three words are the foundation of healthy relationships, that they are the only ceiling on your spiritual, mental, and emotional health, and that they determine how happy you are and how holy you are. If you want to change the world, please, sorry, and thanks must become a way of life.
